

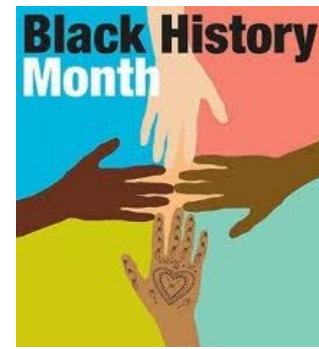
## What's New?

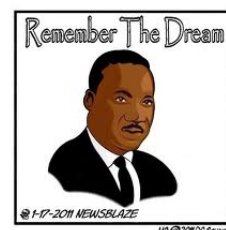
